Creative Clay: A Clay Design Workshop - Grades 6-10:

Have fun expressing your creativity with clay! Create projects using coil, slab and pinch pot techniques. Students will design and create ocarinas, which are small flute-like wind instruments made of clay. Students will learn to paint with glazes and their projects will be ready for pick up the following week. **\$155 supplies included.**

August 1-4 (9 AM-12 PM) OR August 8-11 (1 PM-4 PM)

Drawing 101 - Grades 6-10:

This offering, for artists of all levels, will include the basics of sketching and shading and other drawing techniques. Projects will range from a still life to a self-portrait. Just come with your enthusiasm and creativity and the teacher will guide you. **\$135 supplies included.**

August 1-4 (1 PM-4 PM)

Watercolor Painting - Grades 6-10:

Come have fun this summer learning the basics of watercolors! Students will learn traditional techniques as well as Chinese brush techniques. Students will practice using wet on wet, dry brushing, washes and other techniques of paint application. **\$150 supplies included.**

August 8-11 (9AM-12 PM)

Drama and Acting - Grades 6-8:

This workshop provides young actors with a foundation for basic acting skills while building confidence and creativity through the world of live theater. Students will have the opportunity to practice and perform scenes during the course. **\$140 supplies included.**

August 1-4 (9 AM-12 PM)

Fun with Graphic Design and Photoshop – Grades 6-10:

Participants will learn the basic tools of graphic design using Photoshop software. Lessons will incorporate the users' individual interests in producing their project/s. Students can choose project themes such as music, entertainment, or sports. Design techniques will be introduced so that participants can create a t-shirt design, a CD or DVD cover. **\$160 supplies included.**

August 1-4 (9 AM-12 PM) OR August 8-11 (9 AM-12 PM)

Model Rockets & CO₂ Cars – An Applied Technology Workshop – Grades 7-11:

Participants in this workshop will explore technology through hands on e-designing and fabricating model rockets and CO₂ cars. Students will enjoy learning the basics of rocket and model building in a safe environment. Participants will be instructed in proper/safe methods of using all the tools and equipment needed for this workshop. **\$165 supplies included.**

August 8-11 (1 PM- 4 PM)

Digital Photography Workshop - Grades 6-11:

Students will learn the basics of digital photography. Elements of this course include: learning what your camera can do, photo composition, using Photoshop, and when and how to use professional lighting. This class is designed to give amateurs confidence in knowing how to use their cameras. A limited number of DSLR cameras are available for loan in class use only. **\$175 supplies included, but bring your Camera!**

August 8-11 (1 PM-4PM)

Animation for Beginners - Grades 6-10:

If you have ever wanted to create an animated film or are curious as to how they are created, select this class. Students who complete this course will learn the photographic techniques needed for stop action animation using the digital process. Students will focus on: camera modes, composition, exposure, and editing using Photoshop. The basics of script writing and storyboarding will be included. Cameras, software, and lighting will be provided. Students will need to bring their own flash drive so they can save their creation for viewing with friends and families. **\$160-student supplies flash drive.**

August 8-11 (9 AM-12 PM)

3D Modeling with SketchUp 2015- Grades 6-10:

This exciting course will have students quickly modeling in 3D SketchUp software. Architects and engineers use this program to help visualize their designs. Students will learn how to create and modify 3D models. Effects such as material editing, background scene selection and adding shadows will also be taught. With the software students will be able to create and layout furniture in a room of a house in 3D and print. **\$155 supplies included.**

August 8-11 (9 AM-12 PM)

Discover ALICE Workshop – Grades 6-11

Video Music Lovers-here is a class for you. Enjoy creating and constructing your own music video using the programming language ALICE! Students must supply their own headphones & a flash/thumb drive in order to save their work throughout the week. **\$140-student supplies flash drive & headphones.**

August 1-4 (9 AM-12 PM) OR (1 PM-4 PM)

Boot Camp! - Grades 7-10

Get off the couch! If you are interested in fun activities and feeling great, join us for this workshop. We will explore different aspects of fitness through strength training, TRX, yoga, stretching and fitness games. All levels are welcome as the teacher will individualize instruction. **\$140 supplies included.**
